

2016 King-Pierce Farm Bureau Scholarship Qualifications Information:

- 1) Must be a member of King-Pierce Farm Bureau *or* family member (current membership paid).
- 2) High School Senior graduating this year (2016) and accepted to an accredited post-secondary vocational program, college or university for the following session, *or* a current student.
- 3) One \$2000 scholarship may be awarded to a student who plans to pursue an agricultural related field of study and two \$1000 scholarships may be given to selected students in any field of study.

Additional scholarships and awards may be made to outstanding applicants depending upon available funding

Specific Instructions for HS Seniors and King-Pierce Farm Bureau Scholarship applicants only:

- High School Senior: transcripts through *first semester* of 2015-16 are acceptable.
- Recommendation: letters for HS Seniors can be from school advisors or teachers.
- Submit a *copy of letter of acceptance* for your chosen program or a detailed explanation, if this is not possible by this deadline.

*Current post secondary students please follow WFB guidelines as stated on-line (and return application to the King-Pierce Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee at the above address.

- 5) Return completed application *prior* to deadline of April 30, 2016
- 6) Students who have previously applied or received scholarship awards may re-apply for continued undergraduate or post graduate studies at an accredited college or university by following the above procedures.
- 7) Funds will be made available to the student, fall term 2016.
- 8) Any scholarship awarded shall be used in the academic year following its award. In the event the scholarship is not used within a year's time, the recipient must present a written request for a time extension prior to April 30th of the academic year of the award. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

9) Scholarship student will report back to KPFB of their progress at the completion of his/her first term following the receipt of funds.

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
