



SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- ✿ Two \$2000 scholarship may be awarded to students who plan to pursue an agricultural related field of study
 - ✿ Two \$1500 scholarships may be given to selected students in any field of study
 - ✿ Additional scholarships may be given as funding becomes available
 - ✿ Eligible applicant must be high school senior graduating this year and accepted to an accredited post -secondary vocational program, college or university for the following session; or currently enrolled in an accredited secondary vocation program college or university; or currently enrolled in a field of Agricultural studies (e.g. Food Science, horticulture, ag technical course, animal science, etc.) at an accredited secondary vocational program, college or university
- Applicant must be a Farm Bureau Member or the son, daughter or legal dependent of a Member with a current membership. Applicant may join as an Associate Member for the purpose of obtaining a scholarship—go to <http://wsfb.com/membership/> and follow the instructions provided.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Download and complete a KPFB scholarship application from <http://king-piercefb.org/scholarship-info>
2. High School seniors must include transcripts through first semester of the current school year; letter of recommendation from school advisor and/or teacher; letter of acceptance for chosen program or detailed explanation of chosen program
3. Farm Bureau membership application process must be completed prior to application submission.

2018 WFB Ray DeVries Memorial Scholarship

Five \$2000 Scholarships may be awarded to undergraduate students statewide who are currently enrolled in agriculture or a related field of study at an accredited college or university. Applicants must have completed at least one year of secondary education. A person may receive the scholarship only once and must meet the following requirements:

1. Applicants must be a Farm Bureau Member; or the son, daughter or legal dependent of a Member with a current membership
2. Attending an accredited college or university
3. Enrolled in field of agriculture (e.g. food science, horticulture, ag technical course, animal science, etc.) or in a course as it relates to agriculture
